IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS

Gift Aid Tax Relief is available to UK Charitable Societies with regards to donations of any amount from UK taxpayers (out of their general taxed income). The Society can reclaim tax at no extra cost to the donor. In addition, a donor who is a higher rate taxpayer can claim further relief for their own benefit. It will, therefore, be much appreciated if you complete the Declaration at the foot of this sheet (if you have not done so in previous years) and send it to the Honorary Treasurer, whether you are intending to donate or not, in addition to your annual subscription. This will enable us to keep it on file and use it without troubling you further, when submitting any relevant claim to the Revenue. You can cancel the Declaration at any time by notifying the Honorary Treasurer in writing to that effect. A gift to the Society of any amount, large or small, is of course most welcome regardless of whether Gift Aid is applicable.
